A wonderful world in miniature!

Check if you are perceptive! Do your best and surely your efforts will be rewarded by our conductors. Push your senses to the limit and look carefully for:



Tidbits



The heart of the model is the proprietary computer system consisting of **2 servers** and **12 8-port switches** connected by **14 km of cables**.



It takes **6 hours of work** for an experienced model maker to prepare one figurine, starting from carving in wax, through preparing silicone mold and pouring the resin, ending with manual painting.



The most impressive building in Kolejkowo is the 4-meter model of Radio Gliwice. It took 5 modelers **2245 hours** to build this historic building and, like the original, is made of wood.



In Kolejkowo, trains run at a speed of **1.5 km/h**, translating to **12 km per day**, about **350 km per month** and **4380 km per year**.



In Kolejkowo, the day lasts **9 minutes**, while the night lasts **4 minutes**. After the dusk the street lights and the lights in the houses of miniature inhabitants lit up.



Creating a miniature building is a long process. It is necessary to make documentation, **several hundred photographs** of the original and sizing dimensioning using a laser meter. And at the end is the manual cutting, twisting, filling, sanding, painting, wiring... and ready :)
